#### SFHA New Model Rules 2020

All Registered Social Landlords are required to adopt the SFHA New Model Rules 2020 however, due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic these will be adopted at the Annual General Meeting in September.

#### GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL RECYCLING AND WASTE IMPORTANT INFO GCC Bulky Waste service is now a request-only service.

All previous arrangements of presenting bulk waste at collection points on a designated 'bulk day' will no longer take place.

Once a request is made to GCC, they will let you know where to leave your items for collection.

Please do not leave items on the street or in backcourts – this will be treated as fly-tipping and those responsible will be open to enforcement action.

Household Waste Recycling Centres such as Queenslie remain open with extended hours commencing 19th April—8am-6pm (last entry 5.45pm, 7 Days a Week.

## DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

We are pleased to announce that we are making good progress with the phase 10 development. This will be 84 new build properties on the site at Abbeycraig Road.

The properties will be a mix of 2 storey house types including terraced, cottage flats and one bedroom apartments.

A number of the properties will also be designed specifically for wheelchair users and many others will be barrier free. The houses have been designed to the highest specification and meet Glasgow City Council's Housing Standard.

This is the largest development in the Association's history and is on a prime site with views overlooking the 7 Lochs Wetland Park. We are aiming to ensure that we create a development which people will be excited about and want to live in.

The Association has a further development of 15 new build properties at Abbeygreen Street which will be starting on site at the end of May. This new project (Phase 11) will be a mix of 2 and 3 bedroom terraced homes and 2 bedroom flats similar in style to those in the Abbeycraig Road development.

## SPSO Model Complaints Policy and Procedure 2021

Lochfield Park HA Ltd adopted the SPSO Model Complaints Policy and Procedure at the end of March 2021 and implemented it on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021. The idea of the new Model is that all RSLs have a consistent approach to complaints and complaints handling and everyone is treated fairly, transparently and within agreed timescales.

#### Management Committee

#### We have three vacancies on our Management Committee.

Lochfield Park is run by a Management Committee elected annually within the membership. It is the Management Committee who oversees the work of the Housing Association and has responsibility for agreeing all its policies and procedures.

#### **Membership**

Anyone over the age of 16 is eligible to apply to become a member of Lochfield Park. Membership costs £1 for life. It allows members to receive our Annual Accounts, attend our Annual General Meeting, receive our Annual Report, stand for election to the Management Committee and vote on membership issues.

#### Tenant Panel

Do you have a few hours free to meet a few times a year to look at how certain services can be improved.

A Tenant Panel will help us focus on identifying tenants' needs and how to get the best service and value possible. In addition, the panel would be consulted over new policies and review of existing policies.

#### Welfare Rights Service

Our Welfare Rights Service is still available while the office is closed for all aspects of benefit assistance 5 days a week.

#### **GIANT HOGWEED**

#### What is giant hogweed?

Giant hogweed (Heracleum mantegazzianum) is a weed which is a very invasive plant which is dangerous to humans, but there are ways to stay safe from it if you know what to look out for.

Growing up to five metres tall, its sap contains toxic chemicals which react with light when in contact with human skin, causing blistering within 48 hours. Effectively it prevents the skin from protecting itself from sunlight, which can lead to very bad sunburn and scarring.

It's got green stem spotted with dark red which varies from 3–8 cm in diameter. Each dark red spot on the stem surrounds a hair, and large, coarse white hairs occur at the base of the leaf stalk.

It produces white flowers clustered in an umbrella shaped head that is up to 80cm in diameter across its flat top.

Please contact the office if you spot any hogweed.



### Mini Egg Rice Krispie Squares!

#### Ingredients

Base:

- 50 g Unsalted Butter
- 275 g Mini Marshmallows
- 150 g Rice Krispies
- 200 g Mini Eggs (Whole/Crushed)

#### Topping

300 g White Chocolate 100-200 g Mini Eggs (Whole/ Crushed)



#### Instructions

Line a 9x9" square tin with parchment paper, and leave to the side.

Add the butter and mini marshmallows to a large pan, and heat on a low-medium heat, stirring, until smooth and melted!

Once melted, take the pan off the heat.

Pour the rice krispies into the pan, and stir to combine!

Add in the mini eggs and briefly mix to combine. The mixture will be warm so be quick so the mini eggs don't melt too much.

Press the mixture into the bottom of the lined tin (top tip, buttering your hands slightly can prevent any sticking and makes it easy to press down!)

Melt the white chocolate in a bowl until smooth – (This can be done in short bursts in the microwave stirring well each time).

Pour the melted chocolate over the base, and then sprinkle on the other mini eggs.

Set in the fridge for two or more hours, and then slice and enjoy!

#### Notes

• You can use slightly salted butter it you want the mixture slightly less sweet!

 You can use cocoa pops in place of rice krispies if you want!

• The chocolate topping can be done with other chocolates if you fancy!

Store at room temperature for up to five days!
